

## WHAT'S IN THIS EMAIL

### 1. CAM Card Requirement

Effective March 1, 2011, the new sign-in procedures for drop-in and other club sponsored events will require the showing of a CAM card. If you do not have your card at sign-in, you will be allowed 3 incidences after which you will be turned away from playing. Effective April 1, 2011, anyone not bringing their CAM card to show the monitor at morning drop-in, ladders, skill level drop-in, mixers, or other club sponsored event monitors will have to go home to get their card.

The monitor station will move to the Pavilion and it is extremely important that everyone sign in. Failure to sign in will hurt the clubs usage numbers that is the basis for showing the need for more courts. Please take the time to sign in.

We have checked with CAM regarding hiring monitors to implement this new procedure and have been told it is not allowed. The only contractors allowed are instructors. We have no choice in implementing this new procedure. Therefore, it is more critical than ever that everyone in the club signup for monitoring. If insufficient signups are a result of the new procedure, it is expected that mandatory signups will become necessary and the reduced club dues for monitoring will be dropped.

Again, this change was dictated by Mitzi's e-mail and we have been told that CAM can revoke our charter for not following Charter Club Rules and Regulations. So please bring your CAM cards and certainly do NOT disrespect any monitor for following these procedures.
